

What are the different types of interpreters?

Legal interpreter

In court, at jail, state /federal certification

Medical interpreter

At hospitals, community interpreting, state /federal certification

Conference interpreter

2 terps in a booth at conference, the UN, the EU, major international events, 20-30 mins on each terp, AIC certification

Liaison interpreter

Accompanies clients for business meetings, dinners, corporate events, press announcements, inauguration speeches, presentations and tours

Telephone interpreter

Over the phone, direct cultural 1-1 connection

Remote interpreter

Interpreters at a location where either they, or participants are participating in an assembly or meeting remotely (From a separate location)

Community interpreter

Interpreter for LEP clients in settings such as medical, education, public health, social security, housing, legal and police related
